It is essential therefore that you provide a jpeg digital picture with your application. **Passes will be posted out before the start of term.** Students **MUST** show their Pass every time they board the coach. Travel may be refused to anyone not showing a valid pass.

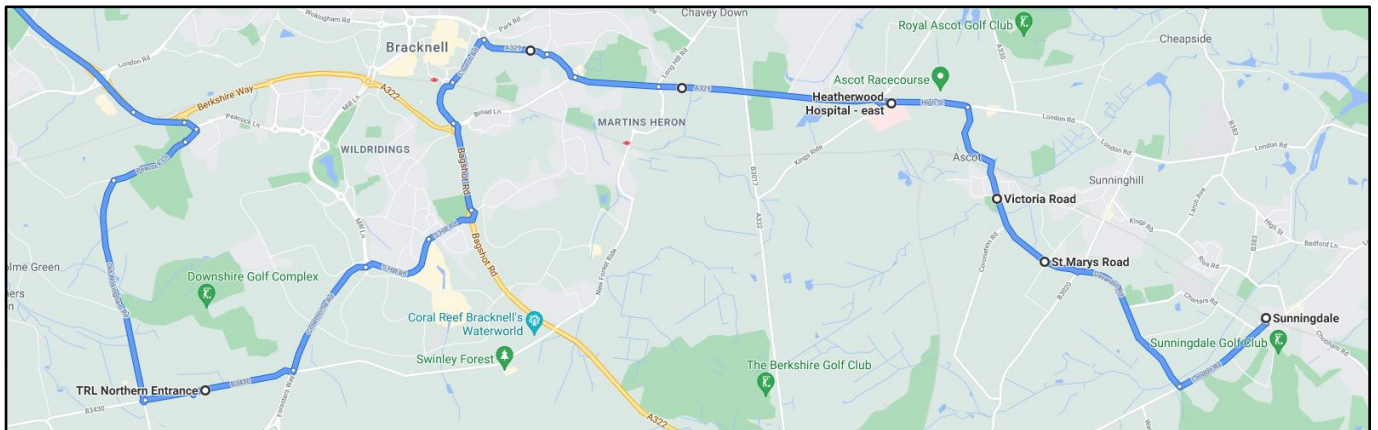

TRAVEL TIPS

1. You should be at the pick-up point at least 5 minutes before the scheduled time.
